Minnesota Girl Slain; Parts of Body Found

ROSEAU, Minn., Sept. 19.—(A)—Charred parts of the body of Anna World. 25, who disappeared August 24, have been found in a burned straw stack, county officers said today. They said the girl, an expectant mother, had been slain.

Carl Brandevold, 30, owner of the farm, is held, but he denied any

knowledge of the crime.

The girl's skull and one leg were found in the burned straw, while the torso had been partly plowed under in the field. Her coat and beads were also found on the farm.

An inquest established the identity of the victim as Anna Wold, Brandvold's sweetheart for the last five years. Evidence showed that the girl had been slain by a shot-gun charge as she sat under a tree on the Brandevold farm and that her body was later covered with oil and ignited.

Brandevold admitted setting fire to the straw pile, but denied he

knew a body was in it.
